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Explanations	
1. B	Holiday names always begin with a capital letter.
2. B	The name of a state begins with a capital letter.
3. C	A street name is a place, so both words begin with capital letters.
4. C	A product name uses a capital letter for each important word.
5. C	Florida is the name of a state, so it needs a capital letter.
6. Halloween	Halloween is a holiday, so it begins with a capital letter.
7. Oak Street	A street name is a place, so both words start with capital letters.
8. F	Thanksgiving is a holiday and must begin with a capital T.
9. C	Ohio is the name of a state and needs a capital letter.
10.	Answer: We go to Disney World in July. Begin the sentence with a capital, capitalize the place Disney World, and capitalize the month July.



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
