Two Texts About Dogs

Text 1: Dogs as Pets. A dog can be a great pet. Dogs are friendly and love to play. A pet dog needs food, water, and a warm bed. It also needs walks and care. A dog gives love back to its family.

Text 2: Dogs That Work. Some dogs do not stay home as pets. They have jobs to help people. A guide dog helps a person who cannot see. A farm dog helps move sheep. A rescue dog helps find people who are lost.

Both texts are about dogs. Both texts tell that dogs help people in some way. But Text 1 is about pet dogs that live with a family. Text 2 is about working dogs that have important jobs.



6. A	Paragraph 3 says both texts tell that dogs help people in some way.
7. B	Text 1 is about pet dogs, while Text 2 is about working dogs.
8. T	Both texts are about dogs, so they share the same topic.
9.	Answer: Both texts are about dogs, and both show that dogs help people. Accept any answer about both being about dogs or dogs helping people.
10.	Answer: Text 1 is about pet dogs at home, but Text 2 is about working dogs with jobs. Accept any answer that contrasts pet dogs with working dogs.
