Quick Review

Many things happen in an order. Words like first, next, then, and last show the steps. Look for how one step leads to the next.

PART 1 — READ

How a Butterfly Grows

A butterfly does not start out with wings. It changes its body in steps. This big change is called metamorphosis. There are four steps. The change takes time, but each step leads to the next one.

First, a mother butterfly lays a tiny egg on a leaf. Next, the egg hatches into a caterpillar. The caterpillar is hungry. It eats leaves and grows bigger and bigger. It eats for many days.

Then the caterpillar makes a hard case called a chrysalis. It stays still inside the case. Last, the case opens. A butterfly comes out with new wings. It dries its wings and flies away to start the cycle again.
