| 3. A | Drinking water is the clue. Thirsty means you need a drink. |
| 4. B | No sound at all means very quiet. |
| 5. B | Too hot to eat is the clue for steaming. |
| 6. B | Almost ninety years old tells you elderly means old. |
| 7. A | Kids laughing is the clue. Amusing means funny. |
| 8. | Answer: hard to lift / very weighty Not being able to lift the box is the clue for heavy. |
| 9. tired | Falling asleep right away is the clue for weary. |
| 10. | Answer: Example: Steep means going up sharply. I know because they had to climb up slowly. Accept any answer that uses the clue about climbing slowly. |
