
Explanations

1. B	Rabbit breaks into rab-bit, which is two syllables.
2. B	Target breaks between the two middle letters into tar-get.
3. A	Napkin breaks into nap-kin, two syllables. The other words have just one.
4. B	Basket breaks into bas-ket, which is two syllables.
5. B	Sunset is a compound word that splits into sun-set.
6. kit-ten	Kitten breaks into kit-ten, two clear chunks.
7. pen-cil	Pencil breaks into pen-cil, two clear chunks.
8. T	Magnet breaks into mag-net, which is two syllables.
9. B	Breaking a word into chunks helps you decode it one syllable at a time.
10. D	Truck has one vowel sound and one syllable. The others each have two.



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
