

<b>6. B</b>	A closing sums up the topic with a strong fact.
<b>7. C</b>	An informative piece teaches facts about a topic.
<b>8. topic</b>	The topic sentence names the topic of the piece.
<b>9.</b>	<b>Answer:</b> Example: A frog is an animal that lives both in water and on land. Accept any clear topic sentence about a real subject.
<b>10.</b>	<b>Answer:</b> Example: Topic: cows. Fact 1: cows eat grass. Fact 2: cows give us milk. Closing: cows are helpful farm animals. Accept any plan with a topic, two facts, and a closing idea.
