The Job of a Firefighter

A firefighter is a brave person who helps keep people safe. When a fire starts, firefighters rush to put it out. They wear thick coats and helmets to protect their bodies. The hot fire cannot reach their skin through this gear.

Firefighters ride in a big red truck. The truck carries long hoses. A hose is a soft tube that water moves through. Firefighters point the hose at the fire. The water flows out fast and stops the flames.

Firefighters do more than fight fires. They also rescue people who are stuck or hurt. They teach kids how to stay safe. A firefighter is a true helper in the community where many people live and work together.

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Explanations	
1. B	A firefighter rushes into danger to help, so brave means not afraid.
2. A	The coats protect their bodies so the fire cannot reach their skin, so protect means keep safe.
3. B	Paragraph 2 says a hose is a soft tube that water moves through.
4. A	The water stops the flames, so flames means the fire.
5. A	The text says firefighters rescue people who are stuck or hurt, so rescue means to save.
6. B	The passage says a community is where many people live and work together.
7. A	The coats and helmets are the gear that protects the firefighter.
8. F	Firefighters rush to a fire, which means they move fast.
9.	Answer: A helper is someone who does things to make life better and safer for others. Accept any answer that says a helper does things for other people.
