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Explanations	
<b>1. B</b>	The word best tells what someone thinks, so it is an opinion.
<b>2. B</b>	It tells why the writer likes summer, so it is a reason.
<b>3. B</b>	The word because joins an opinion with a reason.
<b>4. A</b>	The word also adds one more reason to your writing.
<b>5. C</b>	A good closing sums up the opinion in a strong way.
<b>6. B</b>	After saying you have a reason, you give it.
<b>7. C</b>	It does not state a clear opinion, so it is weak.
<b>8. T</b>	Reasons explain why you hold your opinion.
<b>9.</b>	<b>Answer:</b> Example: I think winter is the best season. Accept any clear sentence that states the writer's opinion.
<b>10.</b>	<b>Answer:</b> Example: School lunch should have more fruit. Because fruit helps kids stay healthy and have energy. For these reasons, more fruit would be a great change. Accept any topic with all three parts: opinion, reason, and closing.



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
