Quick Review

Many verbs add **-ed** to show the past. But **IRREGULAR** verbs change in a special way: go becomes **went**, sit becomes **sat**, hide becomes **hid**, tell becomes **told**, run becomes **ran**, eat becomes **ate**, and see becomes **saw**.


