Explanations	
1. A	Sleepy is an adjective. It describes what the cat is like.
2. B	Loudly is an adverb. It tells how the dog barked.
3. B	Describing words like bright, red, and warm help you picture the flower.
4. A	Soft is an adjective. It tells what the pillow is like.
5. A	Slowly is an adverb. It tells how the turtle moved.
6. B	Gracefully is an adverb that tells how the bird flew.
7.	Answer: Example: friendly, happy, fluffy, brown. Accept any adjective that describes the dog.
8.	Answer: Example: sweetly, softly, loudly, beautifully. Accept any -ly adverb that tells how she sang.
9. T	Adjectives describe nouns, such as a tall tree or a happy child.
