Explanations

1. B	A dictionary tells you the meanings of words.
2. A	Dictionary words are always in ABC order so you can find them fast.
3. B	A glossary is a word list at the back of a book.
4. B	A comes before b, c, and d, so apple comes first.
5. B	All start with f. Looking at the second letter, frog comes last (a, i, o, r).
6. A	Guide words help you find the page your word is on.
7. C	Corn comes between cat and cow in ABC order, so it is on that page.
8. glossary	A glossary lists the meanings of words from the book.
9. F	A comes before b, so apple comes before banana.
10.	Answer: moon, sun, tree ABC order goes by the first letter: m, s, t.
