In the third picture, Ella sits next to a tall sandcastle with shells on top. The crab sits near her feet. The sun is setting, and the sky is orange and pink. The words say, 'It was a perfect day.'



<b>1. B</b>	The first picture shows a green bucket and a red shovel.
<b>2. B</b>	The pictures show yellow sand and the ocean, so it is a beach.
<b>3. C</b>	The second picture shows a small crab peeking out of the hole.
<b>4. A</b>	The picture shows Ella with a big smile, so she is having fun.
<b>5. C</b>	The third picture shows a tall sandcastle with shells on top.
<b>6. B</b>	The setting sun and orange sky show that time has passed.
<b>7. A</b>	Pictures show characters, setting, and events to help readers.
<b>8. F</b>	The pictures show a sunny beach, not a winter day.
<b>9.</b>	<b>Answer:</b> Example: It shows the sandcastle has shells on top and the crab stayed with Ella. Accept any detail seen only in the picture, not the words.
<b>10.</b>	<b>Answer:</b> Example: A picture of Ella waving goodbye to the crab as she leaves the beach. Accept any picture idea that fits the story.



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
