
Explanations

1. A	A dictionary shows the correct spelling of words.
2. B	A dictionary lists words in alphabetical order.
3. B	Apple starts with A, the first letter of the alphabet.
4. C	Zebra starts with Z, the last letter of the alphabet.
5. A	A word wall shows words spelled the right way.
6. B	Cat starts with C, which comes after B and before D.
7. T	A dictionary shows the correct spelling and meaning of words.
8. ant	Ant starts with A, which comes first in the alphabet.
9. C	Use a dictionary or word wall to check the correct spelling.
