

1. B	Compare = show similarities and differences.
2. A	Describe = give details that help a reader picture it.

7. B	Estimate = a reasonable guess. Counting exactly is not estimating.
8. A	Analyze/summarize/predict are common in academic directions.
9. B	Photosynthesis belongs to science. The others are general words.
10.	<b>Answer:</b> Example: If a question asks me to summarize, I would write the main idea and the most important details in my own words. Accept any clear explanation of the chosen academic action.
