

| Explanations | |
|------------------------|--|
| 1. C | Capitalize first and last words and important words; “in” and “the” inside the title stay lowercase. |
| 2. A | Both important words capitalized. |
| 3. C | First word + important words capitalized; “to” and “the” stay lowercase. |
| 4. B | Capitalize first word (A) and important words (Day, Park); “at” and “the” stay lowercase. |
| 5. C | And is a short connecting word that stays lowercase in the middle of titles. |
| 6. | Answer: The Tale of Peter Rabbit First, last, and important words capitalized; “of” lowercase. |
| 7. Finding Nemo | Both words are important. |
| 8. C | “Of” and “a” should be lowercase: Diary of a Wimpy Kid. |
| 9. B | First word capitalized + important words; “to” and “your” are handled correctly (your is a possessive and gets capitalized in titles). |
| 10. | Answer: The Road Not Taken All important words capitalized; “the” (first) capitalized; “not” counts as important. |
