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Explanations	
<b>1. B</b>	Comma inside the quotation marks, then said Maya. The others miss the comma or quotes.
<b>2. B</b>	Comma before the dialogue starts; question mark inside the quotes.
<b>3. B</b>	End the spoken part with a comma INSIDE the quotation marks.
<b>4. B</b>	Exclamation point inside the quotation marks, no extra comma.
<b>5. A</b>	Comma INSIDE quotation marks; statement ends with the comma since the speaker tag follows.
<b>6.</b>	<b>Answer:</b> "I am tired," said Lily. Quotes around the spoken words; comma inside the quote; lowercase "said."
<b>7. A</b>	Comma before quote; period inside the closing quote.
<b>8. B</b>	Question mark should be INSIDE the quotation marks: "Can I come too?"
<b>9.</b>	<b>Answer:</b> "Where is the dog?" asked Tom. Quotes around spoken words; question mark inside quotes.
<b>10.</b>	<b>Answer:</b> Example: "I finished my homework," said Maria. Any sentence with proper quotation marks and punctuation.



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
