## Quick Review

COMPARATIVE words compare TWO things and end in -er (taller, faster). SUPERLATIVE words compare THREE OR MORE and end in -est (tallest, fastest). For long words, use MORE or MOST (more careful, most careful).

Explanations	
<b>1. A</b>	Taller is the comparative for two people. The others are wrong forms.
<b>2. C</b>	Fastest = superlative (compares 3 or more).
<b>3. C</b>	Double the consonant before -er: bigger.
<b>4. B</b>	Use “more” for longer adjectives. The others are wrong forms.
<b>5. C</b>	Best is the irregular superlative of good (compares 3+).
<b>6. B</b>	Use -er, not “more” + -er. C uses “more” with a one-syllable word; D uses superlative incorrectly.
<b>7. C</b>	Easy → easiest (drop y, add iest). The others use wrong forms.
<b>8. heavier</b>	Heavy → heavier (drop y, add ier).
<b>9. tallest</b>	Tall → tallest.
<b>10. B</b>	Adverbs ending in -ly use “more” for the comparative.
<b>11. B</b>	Don’t double the superlative. Should be “the loudest noise.” The others are correct.
<b>12. C</b>	Of three or more → superlative (tallest).
