<b>4. B</b>	Happen + ed = happened (double p in “happen,” add -ed).
<b>5. B</b>	Their shows belonging. The others are wrong spellings or different words.
<b>6. B</b>	With is a simple word with no extra letters.
<b>7. B</b>	Listen contains a silent t.
<b>8. C</b>	Wednesday — capitalize when used as a proper noun; check the d that you don’t hear.
<b>9. B</b>	A lot is always TWO words.
<b>10. A</b>	Enough has an irregular spelling with -ough.
<b>11. always</b>	A-l-w-a-y-s.
<b>12. learn</b>	Common word in the -ear word family (along with year, ear, earth).
