## Quick Review

CONJUNCTIONS connect parts of sentences. COORDINATING conjunctions join equal parts: **and, but, or, so**. SUBORDINATING conjunctions start a part that depends on the main idea: **because, when, if, although, while**.

### Explanations

1. B	But shows contrast. And adds; so shows result; or shows choice.
2. D	Or shows a choice. The others don't fit a choice between two options.
3. C	So shows result/consequence. And just adds; but contrasts; or offers a choice.
4. C	Because starts a dependent clause (subordinating). The others are coordinating.
5. B	Because joins a reason to the main clause. The others use coordinating conjunctions or don't make sense.
6. A	When introduces a time clause. The others are coordinating conjunctions.
7. D	No comma is needed before "when" here. The others are correct.
8.	<b>Answer:</b> after / when / before / if Any subordinating conjunction that shows time or condition.
9. B	If shows a condition. The others join, contrast, or offer choices.
10. A	Although introduces a contrast and connects two ideas. The others are incomplete or misused.
