Diego knew his mother would not let him keep a dog. Still, he could not leave it alone in the cold. He wrapped the dog in his jacket and walked it home, even though he was shivering.

At home, Diego’s mother frowned. “We can’t keep it,” she said. Diego nodded. “I know,” he said quietly. “But maybe we can help find its family.” His mother smiled. Together they made a flyer with the dog’s picture.


Answer Keys

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Explanations	
1. B	Diego helps a shivering dog even at his own cost — that is a kind trait.
2. C	His action of giving up his jacket shows caring.
3. B	A shaking dog is frightened, so whispering helps it feel safe.
4. A	He keeps walking even though he is shivering — comfort matters less to him than the dog.
5. B	Quiet acceptance shows respect and understanding.
6.	Answer: Example: kind — he gave his jacket to the dog. Responsible — he helped make a flyer to find the family. Two traits with text evidence.
7. C	His idea is “maybe we can help find its family.”
8. B	Paragraph 3 shows her frown turn into a smile after Diego's idea.
9.	Answer: Example: He would help the bird carefully, maybe find a box and call for help, because Diego is kind. Accept any answer that matches Diego's caring, careful character.
10. B	Thinking about both the dog AND his mother's wishes shows thoughtfulness.



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
