## Quick Review

A NOUN names a person, place, thing, or idea. A PRONOUN takes the place of a noun (he, she, it, they). A VERB shows an action or state of being. An ADJECTIVE describes a noun. An ADVERB describes a verb, adjective, or other adverb.

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Explanations	
<b>1. C</b>	Dog is a noun (a thing/animal). Barked is a verb; loudly is an adverb; at is a preposition.
<b>2. B</b>	Swims is an action. Maria is a noun (name); pool is a noun; every is an adjective.
<b>3. B</b>	She takes the place of a noun (a name). Painted is a verb; picture and mom are nouns.
<b>4. A</b>	Tall describes the noun tree. Tree and wind are nouns; swayed is a verb.
<b>5. C</b>	Quickly tells HOW he ran (adverb). He is a pronoun; ran is a verb; bus is a noun.
<b>6. A</b>	We replaces a name(s); it replaces a thing. Saw is a verb; park is a noun; at is a preposition.
<b>7. B</b>	Shiny is an adjective describing coin. A uses an adverb; C has no adjective; D is incomplete.
<b>8. happily</b>	Happily tells HOW the baby laughed.
<b>9. A</b>	Red, soft, round describe nouns. The others are verbs, adverbs, or nouns.
<b>10.</b>	<b>Answer:</b> Example: The yellow (adj) bird (noun) sang (verb). Accept any sentence containing all three parts of speech correctly labeled.



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
