A NOUN names a person, place, thing, or idea. A PRONOUN takes the place of a noun (he, she, it, they). A VERB shows an action or state of being. An ADJECTIVE describes a noun. An ADVERB describes a verb, adjective, or other adverb.

Explanations	
1. C	Dog is a noun (a thing/animal). Barked is a verb; loudly is an adverb; at is a preposition.
2. B	Swims is an action. Maria is a noun (name); pool is a noun; every is an adjective.
3. B	She takes the place of a noun (a name). Painted is a verb; picture and mom are nouns.
4. A	Tall describes the noun tree. Tree and wind are nouns; swayed is a verb.
5. C	Quickly tells HOW he ran (adverb). He is a pronoun; ran is a verb; bus is a noun.
6. A	We replaces a name(s); it replaces a thing. Saw is a verb; park is a noun; at is a preposition.
7. B	Shiny is an adjective describing coin. A uses an adverb; C has no adjective; D is incomplete.
8. happily	Happily tells HOW the baby laughed.
9. A	Red, soft, round describe nouns. The others are verbs, adverbs, or nouns.
10.	Answer: Example: The yellow (adj) bird (noun) sang (verb). Accept any sentence containing all three parts of speech correctly labeled.
