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Explanations	
1. B	One girl → apostrophe + s. Girls' would be more than one girl.
2. C	More than one boy → apostrophe AFTER the s.
3. B	Children is an irregular plural → add 's.
4. C	One cat → cat's.
5. B	One dog's bone → dog's.
6. B	Children's = playground that belongs to (or is for) the children.
7. Sam's	Singular name + 's.
8. students'	Plural noun ending in s → just apostrophe.
9. B	Should be "boys" (plural ending in s → apostrophe only).
10. B	People is irregular plural → add 's.
11. C	If the work belongs to multiple students → students' (plural with apostrophe after s).
12. Lee's	Singular name + 's.



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
