## Quick Review

To show that something BELONGS to one person, add an APOSTROPHE + S ('s): *the dog's bone*. For plural nouns ending in -s, add only an APOSTROPHE: *the dogs' tails*. For irregular plurals, add 's: *the children's toys*.

Explanations	
<b>1. B</b>	One girl → apostrophe + s. Girls' would be more than one girl.
<b>2. C</b>	More than one boy → apostrophe AFTER the s.
<b>3. B</b>	Children is an irregular plural → add 's.
<b>4. C</b>	One cat → cat's.
<b>5. B</b>	One dog's bone → dog's.
<b>6. B</b>	Children's = playground that belongs to (or is for) the children.
<b>7. Sam's</b>	Singular name + 's.
<b>8. students'</b>	Plural noun ending in s → just apostrophe.
<b>9. B</b>	Should be "boys" (plural ending in s → apostrophe only).
<b>10. B</b>	People is irregular plural → add 's.
<b>11. C</b>	If the work belongs to multiple students → students' (plural with apostrophe after s).
<b>12. Lee's</b>	Singular name + 's.
