### Explanations

<b>1. B</b>	Add -s for regular plurals. Book's is possessive; bookes is wrong; bookies is unrelated.
<b>2. B</b>	Words ending in -x add -es.
<b>3. B</b>	Change y to i and add -es when a consonant comes before y.
<b>4. C</b>	Irregular: man → men.
<b>5. C</b>	Irregular: child → children.
<b>6. B</b>	Irregular: foot → feet.
<b>7. B</b>	Irregular: tooth → teeth.
<b>8. leaves</b>	Words ending in -f or -fe often change to -ves (leaf → leaves, knife → knives).
<b>9. mice</b>	Irregular plural: mouse → mice.
<b>10. C</b>	Mice is the correct plural of mouse. The others use wrong forms.
<b>11. C</b>	Tables = regular plural. Goose → geese, deer → deer, person → people are all irregular.
<b>12. families</b>	Consonant + y → change to i and add -es.
