

Explanations

1. B	Add -s for regular plurals. Book's is possessive; bookes is wrong; bookies is unrelated.
2. B	Words ending in -x add -es.
3. B	Change y to i and add -es when a consonant comes before y.
4. C	Irregular: man → men.
5. C	Irregular: child → children.
6. B	Irregular: foot → feet.
7. B	Irregular: tooth → teeth.
8. leaves	Words ending in -f or -fe often change to -ves (leaf → leaves, knife → knives).
9. mice	Irregular plural: mouse → mice.
10. C	Mice is the correct plural of mouse. The others use wrong forms.
11. C	Tables = regular plural. Goose → geese, deer → deer, person → people are all irregular.
12. families	Consonant + y → change to i and add -es.



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
