

### Explanations

1. B	<b>Evaporation</b> = liquid water becoming a gas. A is the OPPOSITE (gas to liquid); C is rain/snow falling; D is the breathing process. All four are real science words — only one fits the description.
2. D	<b>Denominator</b> = the bottom number in a fraction (it names the parts the whole is divided into). A is the TOP number; B is what's left after dividing; C is the answer to a division problem. All four are precise math terms.
3. C	A <b>hypothesis</b> is a testable proposed explanation. A — a theory is a well-tested broad explanation that has been supported by lots of evidence; B is what a scientist decides AFTER the test; D is what a scientist NOTICES, not proposes. All four are real science terms.
4. A	<b>Amendment</b> = a formal change to the Constitution. B is choosing leaders; C is a request to a higher court; D is the branch led by the President. All four are real social-studies terms — only one fits.
5. B	<b>Ecosystem</b> = the living community PLUS the non-living parts they interact with. A is a single living thing; C is just the air; D is general surroundings (close, but ecosystem is the precise term).
6. C	<b>Perimeter</b> = total distance around a 2-D shape. A is the space INSIDE; B is the distance across a circle through the center; D is the space inside a 3-D shape. All four are precise math terms.
7. D	<b>Democracy</b> = government in which people choose their leaders by voting. A is rule by a king or queen; B is rule by a single ruler with full power; C is close (a representative form), but the broad term is <i>democracy</i> .
8. C	<b>Habitat</b> = the place where an organism naturally lives. A is a single living thing; B is an animal that hunts another; D is a group of similar living things. The wetland is a PLACE, so <i>habitat</i> fits.
9. A	<b>Citizen</b> = legal member of a country, with rights and responsibilities. B is a government worker; C is someone elected to represent others; D is someone running for office.
10. B	<b>Variable</b> = a letter that stands for an unknown number. A is a fixed number (like 5 or 11); C is a math phrase without an equals sign; D is the number multiplied by the variable (here, 3).
